Backgrounds and Invitation

International Symposium on the Geodynamic Processes of Asia: Its origin, crustal evolution, and natural resources potential has stemmed from a co-operative research project between Mongolia (Research Center for Stratigraphy and Paleontology at Mongolian University of Science and Technology, and Geological Information Center of Mongolia) and Japan (The Nagoya University Museum, Graduate School of Environmental Studies at Nagoya University, Department of Geosciences at Niigata University, and Department of Earth Sciences at The University of Toyama) on geodynamic process of central Mongolia, since 2003. This co-operative academic work was subsequently developed into the agreements on academic exchanging among the RCSP at Mongolian University of Science and Technology, the Geological Information Center of Mongolia, and the Nagoya University Museum.

The IGCP 516 which is an international geoscience programme sponsored by UNESCO aims at understanding the origin and assembly process of Gondwana-derived terranes and the final emplacement of these terranes into the Asian continent during Phanerozoic times. The fundamental goal of this project is to gain paleogeography and paleoenvironment in the eastern Tethys.

We, the organizing committee, would like to call for papers from the geoscientists who are interested in participating this international joint meeting. All researchers with work regarding geology, stratigraphy, tectonics, paleontology, geophysics, geochemistry and mineral deposits of Asia, are welcome to submit their research studies for oral or poster presentations.
